MAKE POLLUTERS PAY
Government applies an incrementally rising fee on fossil fuel pollution at the source



HELP PEOPLE
90% of fees rebated to people equally; 10% for clean energy communities, and businesses



ECONOMICS 101
Costs are passed onto consumers and they consume less carbon. CO2 emissions go down ↓

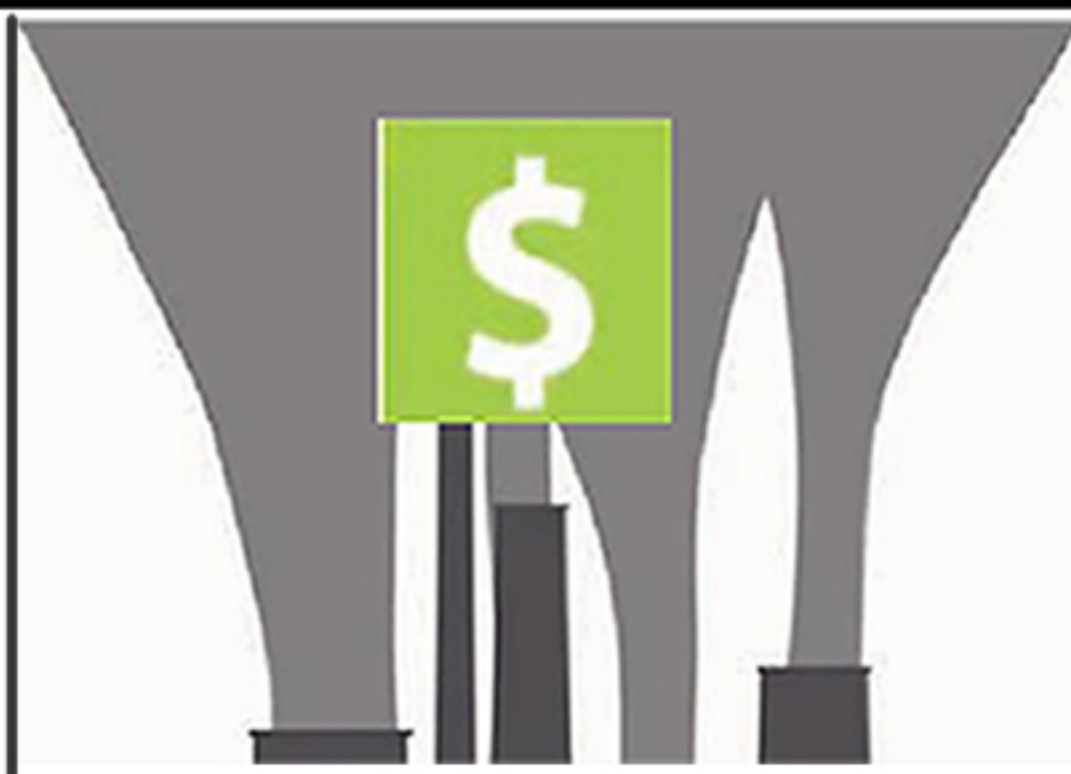


MARKET SOLUTION
The predictable price on carbon spurs clean tech investment & innovation. CO2 emissions go down ↓

Revenue neutral fee on fossil fuel pollution



HELPS FAMILIES
The carbon rebate benefits the poor and middle class because the vast majority will come out ahead



BROAD APPEAL
Libertarians: polluters pay. Progressives: affordability measure. Right leaning: no tax increases



CONSENSUS
The vast majority of economists agree revenue neutral carbon fees are best. Gov't does not pick winners & losers



RAMPING UP
To maintain public support to stabilize CO2 emissions, citizens will need a significant dividend

The Canadian Carbon Rebate is fair to all



MAKE POLLUTERS PAY
Climate change is driving inflation. Fossil fuels are the source >80% of GHGs. Pollution pricing from fossil fuels protects us all.



HELP PEOPLE
The fees are rebated back to us on an equal basis regardless of our carbon footprint and we all benefit from the programs.



REDUCE INEQUALITY
People with lower and middle incomes generally use less fossil fuels thus they come out ahead



PROGRESSIVE TAX
This policy discourages destructive consumptive habits and reward good consumer choices.
